— Non, Maman, j'ai représenté le soleil à l'aube, répond Rajani.

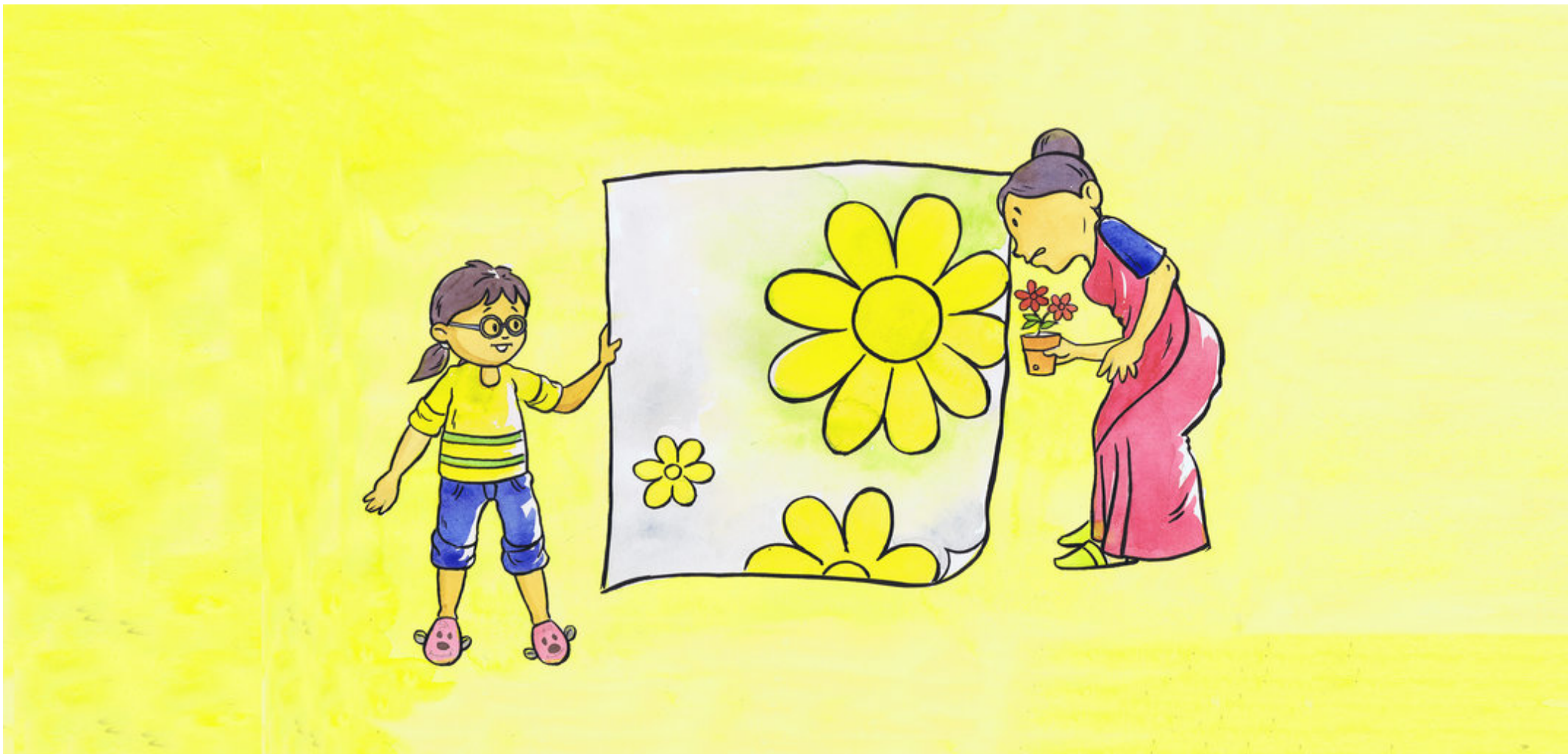


Rajani peint une feuille en marron.

— Non, Maman, c'est une feuille morte.



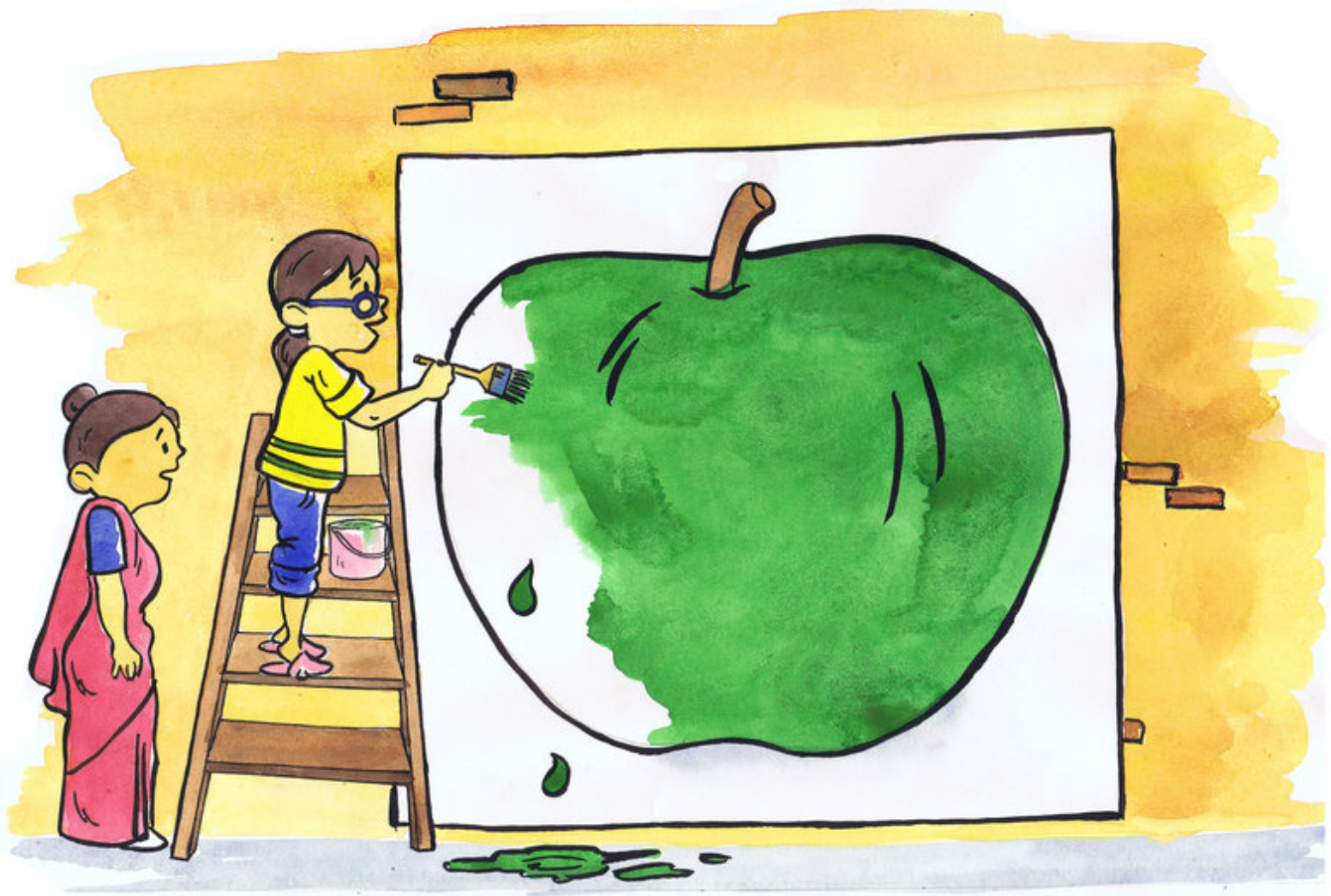
- Regarde, Maman, j'ai peint une très jolie fleur.

Tiens, voici une pomme sucrée.

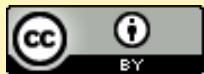
